From the Pastor's Desk

On October 31, 1938, Orson Welles recreated a horrific scene of an alien invasion that frightened thousands of people who listened to his rendition of H.G. Wells novel, *War of the Worlds* on a national radio broadcast. On the following day, newspapers read that thousands of people left their homes in panic and some even placed wet towels

around their faces to protect themselves from gas raids by the aliens.

One article from the *New York Tribune* stated something important for us as Christians, especially Adventist Christians to be aware of; it reads, "They have proved that a few effective voices, accompanied by sound effects, can convince masses of people of a totally unreasonable, completely fantastic proposition as to create a nation-wide panic."

We read in *Matthew 24:4, 5*, "*Beware that no one leads you astray. For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Messiah! And they will lead many astray. Then verse 6 tells us that we "will hear of wars and rumors of war; see that you are not alarmed; for this must take place, but the end is not yet."* This phenomenon will not be a radio broadcast or a televised event, but we will know when this will take place because the Bible has foretold it.

In a world of high technology, we can easily be misled and misinformed by the social media and news media with so much going on in the world. We are told by Jesus not to panic or be alarmed for we know these things are going to take place. Let us all "Keep Awake" and continue praying.
