Seiman, Indonesian Class: Teachers—Hanny Jauwena and Wilson Sinambela. Meets in the main sanctuary.

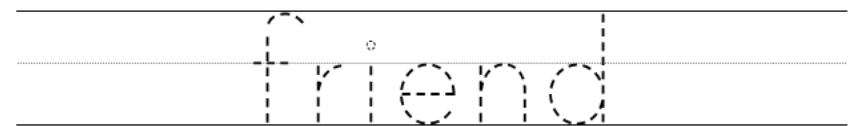
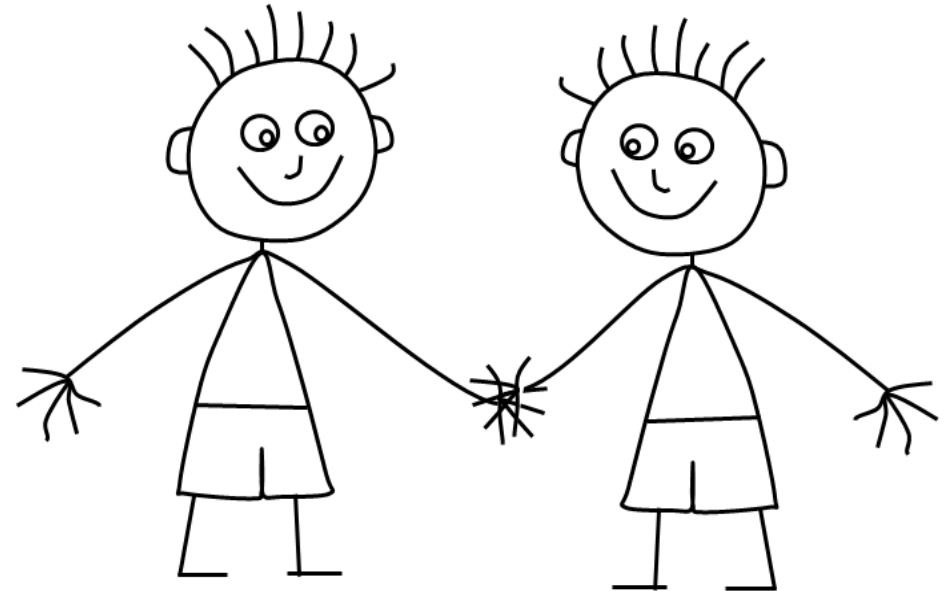
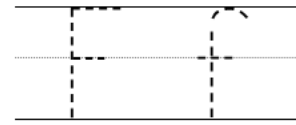
