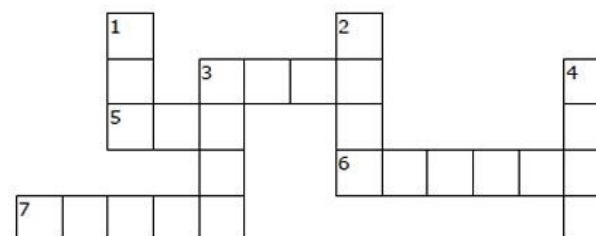
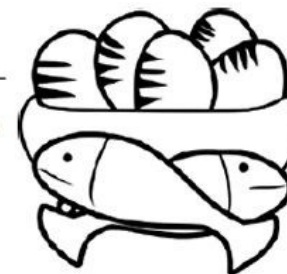
Young Adults Class: SS quarterly taught from a Young Adult perspective for ages 18 to 35. It meets in the Fellowship Hall at 9:45 a.m.
